The Nat Washington House is a 1909 Bungalow that was home to former Washington State Senator, Nat Washington. It is located at: 42 C Street, NW, Ephrata (across the street from the Grant County Courthouse.) His son, Nat, was in EHS Class of 1964.

This is the perfect place for a special occasion gathering, *such as our EHS 1963 50th Class Reunion*. Senator Nat Washington is an important figure in the history of Ephrata and surrounding areas. This house, where he lived for a considerable time, has been renovated, is ADA accessible (ramp, no elevator), and has a warm and welcoming atmosphere.

General Information

The main floor & second floor each have kitchenettes w/microwaves & refrigerators and full bathrooms. The main floor has a beautiful dining room and living room, in addition to a nice sitting room on the second floor.
