Dr. Gerald "Jerry" Hartman, DDS Class of 1959 Ephrata Alumni Association Noted Alumni





Jerry Hartman moved to Ephrata in 1954 to attend Ephrata High School. During his high school years, he was participated in school leadership rolls and was an outstanding athlete.

As a member of the "Orange E" letterman club Jerry served as club secretary his sophomore year and president during his junior year. During his senior year he was elected as the class of 1959's vice-president and represented the class as vice-president in the House of Representatives.

During the years Jerry played at the center position on the Tiger football team it won the North Central Washington "A" league championship two years in a row. During the 1958-59 season the team was ranked as third in statewide Associated Press class "A" poll. Three members of this team, including Jerry, were nominated for the High School All-American Football team. Jerry was presented the team's inspirational football award. A highlight of his career was when the Tigers ran up one of the highest scores, at that time, in the history of Ephrata High School football teams by trouncing the Quincy Jackrabbits 63 to 0.


For four years Jerry was a member of the Tiger wrestling team. His senior year the team finished second place at the state tournament held at Pullman, WA. Six members of the team placed fourth or better. The team record was 10 win, 3 losses (two to powerhouse Moses Lake and one to Cheney). The team scored wins over larger schools including Wenatchee, Eastmont and Pullman. Jerry greatly contributed to the success of the team.

Because of Jerry's notable participation on sports teams, he became recognized and endeared by his entire hometown and garnered the community's support, propelling him forward to successfully set and reach high goals.

After graduating from Ephrata High School, Jerry:

- Attended Washington State University where he was a member of the Lambda Chi Alpha fraternity and was a National Collegiate Athletic Association varsity wrestler until turning his eyes to academics in pursuit of graduate school.
- Started doctorate program at the University of Washington School of Dentistry in 1963 which influenced the course of his life and career. Was selected as a student Naval Dental Officer while in dental school. Upon graduation on June 13, 1967 he was commissioned. Reported for his dental internship as a Lieutenant at St. Albans Hospital in Queens, New York.
- Was assigned to Yokosuka, Japan for three years during the Vietnam War to support evacuated wounded troops. This surgical experience was pivotal in accelerating his career and desire to pursue an advanced residency in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery at the San Diego Naval Hospital. Upon completion of his residency he was assigned to the USS Constellation CV64 Aircraft Carrier as the head of the Dental Department.
- Left active duty as a Commander in the Navy in 1978 and joined a private practice at Oral Surgical
 Associates in Tacoma, WA. Became one of the leading Boarded Oral Maxillofacial Surgeons on the
 West Coast. Retired in 2014 and spent his time working in his garden, traveling all over the world,
 fishing and enjoying the company of his friends, family and wife Susan, an Ephrata High School
 graduate in the class of 1958.
- Was able to overcome the significant hurdles which he faced early in his life and forged a strong loving family and successful career. Jerry Hartman died on February 15, 2020


