

Debbie (Agranoff) McDonnell



McDonnell graduated from EHS in 1973 as a school track star. She participated in track all four years at EHS and is tied for the school record with Heidi Moritz (1991) in the 100-yard dash with a time of 12.5 seconds. McDonnell participated in Washington's first Girls State Invitational in 1973 where, despite competing with an injured foot, she brought home first place in the 100-yard-dash and 4x4 relay and second in the 70-yard dash. McDonnell was part of the first ever state championship team for Ephrata High School in 1973, and was inducted in 2021 to the Ephrata High School Athletic Hall of Fame as a member of that team. She returned to EHS as an assistant track coach, serving the Tigers from 2007-2011.
