
## SCOTT SMITH



Smith graduated from EHS in 1986 earning a total of eight letters in football, basketball and baseball. He was a standout quarterback on the 1985 EHS football team, helping the team to the state quarterfinals and earning a place on the Caribou Trail League first-team, all conference. Smith was a member of the third place 1983 EHS state basketball team, earning all-league recognition. In baseball, he was an all-

league third baseman three years running, from 1983-1986. Smith tied the school record (at the time) for single season home runs (seven) in 1985 and was the leader in most of the offensive statistical categories during his three seasons. He was a member of the 1985 EHS baseball state championship team and went on to play in the All-State game. After graduating, Smith played on the USA Baseball team during the summer of 1986. He went on to play four years of baseball at Washington State University.
